

Texas GHG Registry Activities

On July 5, 2000, Henry Lowerre, and Frederick, LLP on behalf of Public Citizen's Texas, Office, Clean Water Action, Lone Star Sierra Club, Sustainable Energy and Economic Development Coalition, and Texas Campaign for the Environment, filed a petition for rulemaking requesting that the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) initiate a rulemaking to expand the scope of data collected in the annual air emissions inventory to include levels of CO₂ and methane and to create an advisory council to study the cost and benefits of reducing GHG emissions by 7 percent below 1990 levels. In response to this, on August 25, 2000 The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission issued a decision directing the Executive Director to (among other things) create a GHG registry by December 1, 2001.
